Please know that maintaining resident and staff health, wellness, and safety is our number one priority. We are taking steps now to prevent this illness and be positioned to respond quickly and effectively should it impact someone at our community. Here are a few examples of actions that we have taken:

- Emergency preparedness and infection prevention and control plans are in place.
- We are closely monitoring the latest information from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (DPH) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and we are working with state and local public health and emergency preparedness officials to strengthen our preparation for a possible outbreak of Coronavirus.
- At this time at Newbury Court, signs are posted at all entrances asking visitors about recent travel and health status, and staff is screening visitors whenever possible.
- Starting today, March 10, 2020, outside guests are not allowed to attend community programs.
- Rivercrest, our Skilled Nursing neighborhood, is currently closed for visitors.
